

Evaluation for PRO Acceptance List Collection

This document is part of a series of six support documents Circular Action Alliance (CAA) created to help **local governments** prepare for their next step in the implementation of the Recycling Modernization Act (RMA).

Specifically, CAA is asking each community to use these documents as tools to prepare for the Oregon Recycling System Optimization Project (ORSOP), which will take place from May through August of 2024. These documents call out the areas of consideration and data necessary for communities to **effectively identify their system expansion needs** for the ORSOP effort. When funding requests are made during the ORSOP response period (May – August 2024), supporting documentation gathered from these preparedness documents may be requested.

This document will help jurisdictions evaluate the potential of adding materials on the PRO acceptance list to their existing depot collection sites or collection events. The PRO (CAA) would finance the cost associated with adding and managing the PRO materials to existing depots.



PRO Acceptance List

DEQ requires PROs to provide for the recycling of the following materials.

Steel and aluminum aerosol packaging	Single-use liquid fuel canisters and other pressurized cylinders
Aluminum foil and pressed foil products	Glass packaging (e.g., bottles and jars)
Shredded paper	Polyethylene film
Plastic buckets and other bulky HDPE (#2) or polypropylene (#5) packaging	HDPE package handles (such as 6-pack handles)
Polyethylene and polypropylene lids	Block white expanded polystyrene

- Space for the footprint of the equipment (examples include the <u>Runi SK370</u> and the <u>GreenMax</u> compactor)
- Foam storage for unprocessed EPS
- Pallet storage for processed EPS
